#### Summary

The primary work of the Fellow for Outreach + Radical Welcome is to gather students who are Black, Indigenous, and People of Color who are interested in a Queer affirming, curiosity driven Christian community, and work with them to build and nurture spaces where they can grow in their faith. This position will also tend to interfaith relationships and expand capacity for Interfaith work on campus. The Fellow will also participate in the ongoing work of LCM on the campus of the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities.

This position is 15 hours a week, 10 months a year, and offers a \$10,000 stipend each year in addition to robust mentorship and opportunities for learning and growth.
